

Feed-in Tariffs (FiT)



FiTs are regular payments for households that generate their own electricity from:

- solar PV panels
- wind turbines
- micro combined heat and power
- hydro-electric

The [feed-in tariff](#) helps you to save money in three ways:

1. A payment for all the electricity you generate during the tariff period (20 years)
2. A payment for the electricity you export into the grid (for example when you are not at home)
3. A reduction on your standard electricity bill, from using energy you generate.

There are different tariff levels for renewable energy technologies. The government can change the tariffs as often as every 3 months but once you have registered, your tariffs remain the same (and are adjusted in line with inflation) for as long as your installation is eligible. The level of the tariff depends partly on the energy efficiency of your home - **more efficient homes get more.**
